GENERAL SYCHAR TIPS CHECKLIST

- See historical Camp photos in the hotel lobbies.
- Prayer Bell daily at 1pm. Each day for 3 minutes campers of every age either pray or stand in silence / reverence for the Lord.
- Sychar Pancakes are a must have!
- It's a good idea to bring seat cushions for the tabernacle pews.
- Bring your bible and a notebook to all services.
- Make sure kids bring swimsuits for slip-n-slide day.
- The pool across the street usually discounts prices 50% during the Knox County Fair.
- The kids typically do a t-shirt craft so please bring a white t-shirt for your child.
- You can order a pizza at the Sychar Snack Shop to eat after the evening service.
- Please refrain from using the sidewalks next to the tabernacle during service times if you are just passing by.

MORE SYCHAR TIPS!

- MUSICAL GOODNIGHT 10:30 PM** — Main Tabernacle. If you have never gone before, go at the beginning of camp because you will want to go again. It is a very moving spiritual experience watching people come in from out of the darkness as praises to God are being lifted up in song.
- Children should plan to bring snacks/goodies to share during the movie nights in the children's tabernacle. Kids will need their blanket, pillow, PJs, and snacks.
- Make sure to catch the Children's and Youth talent shows, they are very fun to watch. The Youth's Talent show is typically on Friday after the night service.
- Bring dollars to buy your kids tickets to play games for prizes on Missionary Day. It's \$1 for 5 tickets. Bring a checkbook to bid on baskets/homemade goods/etc. All proceeds go to missions.
- The last night of camp the Bookstore and SnackShop have clearance sales after evening services and it also ends up being a social gathering for the whole camp.
